After the mobility

Evaluation of the level acquired

- Interviews are conducted with the participants to determine the initial level of professional training acquired (before)
- After the mobility, interview the participant to list the progress of the mobility
- Verifies if formal requirements and the stipulations stated in the learning agreement have been met



Validation and recognition (ECVET)

- Compare the learning outcomes documented in the learners' Personal Transcript prepared by the hosting institution **with those** agreed upon in the Learning Agreement
 - If everything is correct → skills and competences will be validated
- **Knowledge, skills and competences acquired** are recognized in the home country by officially attesting achieved knowledge, skills and competences
- Awarding the respective amount of **ECVET points** to the learner

Evaluation professionals

- They have to be interviewed to see the knowledge acquired in the mobility
- Socialization of the knowledge acquired → **the professional/staff have to share**, through a meeting, with the other professionals **the knowledge acquired and all the relevant facts from the mobility** that will help their work and that could be implemented



REMEMBER

- You must complete the form in the Mobility Tool (learners and staff)
- Participants must complete a MT questionnaire about the experience
- You must keep the documents for several years (at least 5), so, archive all the documents and make sure you have them all signed and filled
 - Tip → a check list can help to be sure you have collected everything you may need in case of an audit



DISSEMINATION

- After the project it is always a good idea **to share the participants experience through your web page, social media** and the different communication channels your organization may have.
